


Preventing and Responding to Sexual Harassment of women at Work place

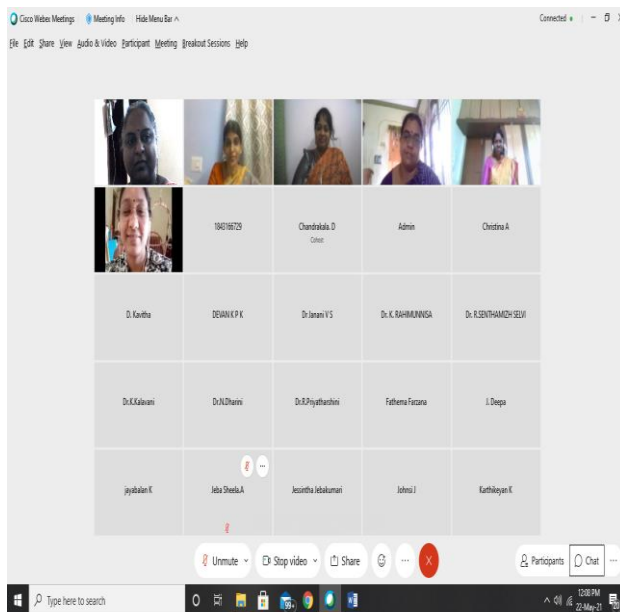
