## DISCIPLINARY ACTION FOR MALPRACTICES / IMPROPER CONDUCT IN EXAMINATIONS

Violation of the rules in any form during the examinations will attract punishment ranging from levying fine to permanently debarring the student from continuing his / her studies as given below.

S.No	Nature of Malpractice	Punishment
1	Appeal by the student is found in the answer script to show mercy by way of awarding more than the deserving marks.	Fine of Rs. 1000/- per course.
2	The student writes his/her name in the answer script.	
3	The student writes his/her registration number/college name in places other than specified in the answer script.	
4	Any special marking is found in the answer script by the student.	
5	The student communicates with the neighbouring student orally or nonverbally; the student causing suspicious movement of his/her body.	
6	Irrelevant writing by the student is found in the answer script.	
7	The student writes answer on his/her question paper or making use of his/her question paper for rough work.	
8	The student either possesses the question paper of another student or passes his question paper to another student with the question paper containing no additional writing on it.	
9	The student possesses cell phones / programmable calculator(s)/any other electronic storage device(s), gadgets.	Invalidating the examination of the particular course written by the student.
10	The student facilitates the other student (s) to copy from his/her answer script.	

11 12 13	The student possessing any incriminating material(s) (whether used or not). For example:- Written or printed materials, bits of papers containing written information, writings on scale, calculator, handkerchief, dress, part of the body, hall ticket etc. The student possesses cell phone(s)/programmable calculator(s)/any other electronic storage device(s), gadgets and containing incriminating materials (whether used or not). 19	Student destroys any evidence relating to an alleged irregularity.	<ul> <li>Invalidating the examinations of the course concerned and all the theory and the practical courses of the current semester for which the student registered.</li> <li>Further the student is not considered for revaluation of answer scripts of the arrear courses.</li> <li>If the student has registered for arrear courses only, invalidating the examinations of all the arrear courses for which the student registered.</li> <li>Additional punishment:</li> <li>If the student has not completed the programme, he/she is debarred from continuing his/her studies for one year i.e., for two subsequent Semesters. 22	The student harasses or engages others to harass on his / her behalf an invigilator, official, witnesses or any other Person in relation to an irregularity by making telephone calls, visits, mails or by any other means.	
23	Student possesses any firearm / weapon inside the examination hall	
24	Vulgar/offensive writing by the student is found in the answer script.	
25	The student possesses the answer script of another student.	Invalidating the examinations of all the theory and practical courses of the current semester and all the arrear courses for which the student registered.
26	The student is found passing his/her answer script to another student.	
27	The student misbehaves in the examination hall.	Invalidating the examinations of all the theory and practical
28	Involved in anyone or more of the Malpractices of serial no.9 to 22 for the second or subsequent times.	courses of the current semester and all the arrear courses for which the student registered. Additional punishment:

		<ul> <li>'bonafide student', the impersonating student is debarred from continuing his / her studies and writing the examinations permanently. He / She is not eligible for any further admission to any programme of the college.</li> <li>Debarring the 'bonafide student' for whom the impersonation was done from continuing his / her studies and writing the examinations permanently. He/She is not eligible for any further admission to any programme of the college.</li> </ul>
