camp started with Mr. Karalmarks highlighting the importance of first aid and further spoke about how simple technique or procedures could save the life of an individual. Firstly, Sir questioned the participants on various basic steps they think is an appropriate response to an accident. Sir then said that the first step towards helping a victim is to make sure that you as an individual are in a safe and protected environment. The next step is to try to wake that person by tapping on his shoulders since it is one of the most sturdy places to apply force without further alleviating the condition of the victim. The following step is to check whether the victim is breathing and to do this lower your ear to the nasal hole of the victim and try to feel the exhaling air while simultaneously observing the movement of the chest up and down. The next step, which is one of the most important step is to slightly lift the chin with one hand and support the motion in the same direction with the other hand on the forehead, this one simple technique can save a person's life as the tongue is the part of the body which restricts the person to breathe. Before performing the first aid, point someone from the public with the help of visual code and instruct him/her to call the ambulance (108)

immediately. Now, if the victim is breathing you have to perform the Recovery Position, that is the victim's left hand(or right) should be placed in T-Position and the victim's off hand should be placed like a "V" over the chest. Then with one hand on shoulder and other on the leg, push the victim in a sideways position towards you. This enables faster head and heart blood circulation and the tongue again will not block the airway. But if the victim is not breathing then we have to perform "CPR" (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation), which was taught by Mr. Karalamrks. It must be performed in cycles of 30.

This event was a major success with many volunteers who were willing to learn and demonstrate the techniques to the fellow participants.
